Tasmania's Bruny Island, on Nuenonne Country, is historically significant to the MSS. It's the place where our story begins. It was on Bruny Island that our founder, Fr John Wallis, first heard the call of a mother, Mrs Kit Hawkins, who asked: 'Who is looking after us in the bush?'

And so, Bruny Island has become a special place of pilgrimage for all involved with the MSS and Highways and Byways, especially as 2024 marks the MSS's 80th year since foundation. Participants walk the land and get in touch with the places that have significance to our mission. Using Captain Cook Caravan Park at Adventure Bay as our base, each morning we meet for a reflection and then head off on walks (of varying levels of fitness) in areas of particular interest and importance to our story. We meet again in the late afternoon each day for a time of sharing stories and reflections. On Sunday, we join the local community in Alonnah for their monthly Mass.
